**SUBJECT: Plan Approval Extension Requests During Current Maryland State of Emergency
(re: Governor's Order No. 20-06-19-01)**

The approval period for each sediment and erosion control plan with an approval expiration date after March 5, 2020 is automatically extended throughout the duration of the current Maryland State of Emergency ordered by the Governor of the State of Maryland via Order No. 20-06-19-01.

Any plan scheduled to expire during the State of Emergency that does not have an extension request submitted by the 30th day after the date by which the State of Emergency is terminated would no longer be valid and would then need to be submitted as a new plan adhering to current standards and current review fees.

Despite the current State of Emergency, the Charles Soil Conservation District has maintained continuance of operations and expects to throughout the remainder of the emergency. Normally expiring extension requests will be reviewed for approval as typical. Delayed plan extensions due to the State of Emergency Order will be based on the original expiration date, not a delayed approval date.

Any plan approval having expired prior to March 5, 2020 is also no longer valid. If approval of such a plan is required, the plan must be submitted as a new plan adhering to current standards and current review fees.

Submittal of plan approval and extension requests remain the responsibility of the owner and all fees remain applicable.
